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1.0 Definition of Student Member

1.1 Definition

- 1.1.1 Student Member is an Affiliate Membership class with no voting rights.
- 1.1.2 Student Members do not have post nominals.
- 1.1.3 Student Members cannot stand for election on Institute Boards and Councils at a Divisional or National level.
- 1.1.4 Student Members are not required to undertake Continuing Professional Development.

2.0 Student Membership Applications

2.1 Applicants must supply all of the following:

- Completed application form
- Proof of enrolment in an API accredited course.
- Membership fee – payable at time of application.

2.2 Applicants must:

- Be a person of good character and repute
- Be undertaking an accredited course of the Institute (All current relevant courses are listed on www.api.org.au)

3.0 Admission as a Student Member

3.1 Every application for admission as a Student Member will be referred to the Divisional Membership Committee for recommendation.

3.2 Divisional Council will consider the recommendations of the Membership Committee but may also inform itself in regard to any application from any other source.

3.3 The Divisional Executive Officer will notify the applicant of the decision.

3.4 Divisional Council shall, at any time, have the ability to make enquiries on the current status of Student Members so as to satisfy itself of the bona fides of this status.

4.0 Approved Professional Experience

There are no approved professional experience requirements for Student Membership.

5.0 Membership / Academic Qualifications / Certifications

All students should ensure that the course enrolled in will enable them to satisfy the academic requirements for the membership level and/or designation/certification wishing to be obtained. If in any doubt students should contact the relevant Institute Divisional Office to discuss.
